

PE

Children will be developing their gymnastic skills. This will include balance, travelling, jumping and rolling, creating sequences and using apparatus.

Children will also be developing their skills in Invasion Games, starting with Tag Rugby

Science

We will be learning about Electricity, creating circuits and identifying common appliances

We will then move on to exploring Sound, looking at how different sounds are made.

Music

Music throughout the term will focus on rhythm and patterns, improvisation and performance and will feature some songs you may recognise, including:


- 1960s/1970s/1980s

Maths

The children will start by recapping Number and Place Value, and will quickly move on to Counting and Comparing numbers up to 10,000.

We will then look at ordering numbers including decimals. Negative numbers and Roman Numerals will also be taught.

Throughout the term, there will be a focus on Times Tables, especially the 6, 7 and 9 times tables.



English

Our Reading and Writing for this term will be based around the book 'The Time Travelling Cat'

We will have regular writing sessions, where the emphasis will be on 'quality not quantity'. Children will work on handwriting throughout the term.

Fiction Writing: Our focus will be writing to entertain, and we will write our own narrative based on The Time Travelling Cat.

Non-Fiction: We will use our knowledge of Ancient Egypt to write explanation texts.

DT

DT will focus on Egyptian jewellery, and the children will have a chance to design and make their own.

Entry / Exit points:

Entry point: Egyptian Day

Exit point: Egyptology Exhibition

French

Pupils will recap classroom equipment, and then learn French verbs and adjectives, alongside learning their birthdays

Art

Our Art work will have an Ancient Egyptian feel - as we look at the Ancient Tomb art.

SMSC

Pupils will be given regular opportunities through a range of subjects to discuss own opinions and beliefs and listen to the opinions and beliefs of others.

Geography

We will locate where Egypt is on a world map. Also we will look at placing the important sites of Ancient Egypt onto a map.

RE / PSHCE

In RE pupils will learn all about the festival of Harvest. We will then explore the religion of Hinduism and what it means to be a Hindu today.

In PSHCE we will be learning about how to be a good learner, working together as a team, managing our feelings and taking personal responsibility for our actions and our behaviours.

History

Our topic is 'Temples, Tombs and treasures' - a fascinating look into the world of Ancient Egypt! The children will explore all areas of this fantastic civilisation, from society, pharaohs, pyramids and Gods and Goddesses. As much as possible, our learning will be linked to Ancient Egypt

Computing

Children will learn about staying safe online at home and at school with an eSafety topic. This will also include using Computing equipment safely.

Pupils will continue to use technology to help them research, present and share their work.
